

Field post station (ППС) 557, 18.2.1943 to Gorky oblast, Russian republic, censored at BПБ БЛ (1st Shock Army), 2nd period. ППС 557 belongs to Northwestern Front staff, 1st Shock Army was part of the Northwestern Front. It is two different types, usage is May 1942 to April 1943, with 17 numbers in the range 1 to 28. ВПБ БЛ (2nd period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 45, 140, 191, 261, 1513, 1516, 1822.



Field post base BIII, 11.9.1942 to Moscow, Russian republic, censored at BΠΕ BIII (53<sup>rd</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. BΠΕ BIII belongs to 53<sup>rd</sup> Army, Northwestern Front. Field post cancels from field post bases (ΒΠΕ) are rare. Usage is June 1942 to May 1943, with 10 numbers in the range 2 to 24. BΠΕ BIII (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 261, 1476, 1701, 1826, 1926, 2436.

The triangular cancel is a postage free cancel for soldiers.



Field post station (ΠΠC) 2169, 26.11.1942 to Gorkovskaya railroad, Russian republic, censored at BΠБ AБ (4<sup>th</sup> Shock Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period.

ΠΠC 2169 belongs to 274th Fighter aviation division, 3rd Air army, Kalinin front.

Usage is July 1942 to March 1943, with 13 numbers in the range 1 to 27.

BПБ АБ (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 340, 414, 629, 1407, 1711, 2169



Field post number (ΠΠΗ) 01835, 22.4.1943 to Moscow oblast, Russian republic, censored at BΠΕ BH (16<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period.

ΠΠΗ 01835 belongs to 27<sup>th</sup> Guard Infantry Regiment, 11<sup>th</sup> Guard Infantry Division, 16<sup>th</sup> Army, Western Front. Usage is February 1942 to April 1943, with 18 numbers in the range 1 to 40.

BIIE BH (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 220, 221, 301, 482, 600, 927, 957, 1560, 1773, 1824, 1828, 1863.



Field post station (ΠΠC) 812, 28.3.1942 to Sverdlovsk oblast, Russian republic, censored at BΠE B (30<sup>th</sup> Army), 1<sup>st</sup> period. ΠΠC 812 belongs to 16<sup>th</sup> Guard Rifle Division, Kalinin Front.

Usage is March 1942 to January 1943, with 5 numbers in the range 3 to 28.

BIIE B (1st period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 214, 812.

Identified censor cancels from the 1st period are very rare.



Field post station (ΠΠC) 812, 1.1.1943 to Sverdlovsk oblast, Russian republic, censored at BΠE B (30<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. Same sender and receiver for both cards. This shows the fact that the field post address was changed in between these dates. The address "44<sup>th</sup> Guard Artillery Regiment", was changed to "Unit 650" out of secrecy reason. Usage is May 1942 to February 1943, with 16 numbers in the range 3 to 30. BΠΕ B (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 214, 812, 871, 1435, 1440, 1443, 1560, 1608, 1843





31st Army (ВПБ БЖ) 20th Army (ВПБ БМ)

Field post station (ППС) 1411, 29.3.1943, to Moscow, Russian republic, censored at BПБ БЖ ( $31^{st}$  Army),  $2^{nd}$  period. ППС 1411 belongs to  $331^{st}$  Infantry Division,  $31^{st}$  Army, Western Front.

It is two different types, usage is April 1942 to April 1943, with 13 numbers in the range 1 to 30.

ВПБ БЖ (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 134, 301, 332, 390, 690, 756, 810, 1411, 1442, 1596, 1614.



Field post station ( $\Pi\Pi$ C) 912, 5.10.1942 to Moscow, Russian republic, censored at B $\Pi$ B BM ( $20^{th}$  Army),  $2^{nd}$  period.  $\Pi\Pi$ C 912 belongs to  $22^{nd}$  Tank Brigade,  $20^{th}$  Army, Western Front.

It is three different types, usage is March 1942 to March 1943, with 25 numbers in the range 1 to 34. BΠΕ ΕΜ (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 38, 250, 335, 608, 690, 756, 814, 830, 912, 1517, 1568, 1597, 1642.


Field post station (ППС) 312, 3.3.1942 to Yaroslavl, Russian republic, censored at BПБ АЖ ( $49^{th}$  Army),  $1^{st}$  period. ППС 312 belongs to  $217^{th}$  Infantry Division,  $49^{th}$  Army, Western Front.

Usage of rectangular censor cancel is August 1941 to March 1942, usage of regular censor cancel is February to March 1942. BΠΕ ΑЖ (1st period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 312. Identified censor cancels from the 1st period are very rare.

Field post station (ΠΠC) 312, 6.8.1942 to Yaroslavl, Russian republic, censored at BΠБ AЖ (49<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ΠΠC 312 belongs to 217<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, 49<sup>th</sup> Army, Western Front. It is three different types, usage is March 1942 to April 1943, with 20 numbers in the range 2 to 32.

ВПБ АЖ (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 92, 312, 487, 690, 786, 1655, 2401.



Field post station (ΠΠC) 965, dated 26.10.1942 to Ivanovo oblast, Russian republic, censored at BΠE AH (3<sup>rd</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period.

ΠΠC 965 belongs to 283rd Infantry Division, 3rd Army, Bryansk Front.

It is two different types, usage is June 1942 to April 1943, with 14 numbers in the range 2 to 30.



Field post station (ППС) 965, 4.2.1943 to Ivanovo oblast, Russian republic, censored at ВПБ АН (3<sup>rd</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. One of the few cancels that uses the "Проверено" instead of "Просмотрено" in the text. ВПБ АН (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 311, 679, 965, 1618, 1754, 2541.



Registered, field post station (ΠΠC) 442, 1.10.1941, to Moscow, Russian republic, censored at BΠE AB (13<sup>th</sup> Army), 1<sup>st</sup> period. ΠΠC 442 belongs to Staff 13<sup>th</sup> Army.

Usage is October 1941, with only this recorded letter. BHE AB (1st period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 442 Postage is 60 kop. for registered letter in the period 6th Feb. 1939 – 15th Sep.1948. Registered field post is rare.

Field post station (ΠΠC) 442, 13.10.1942 to Sverdlovsk oblast, Russian republic, censored at BΠE AB (13<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ΠΠC 442 belongs to Staff 13<sup>th</sup> Army.


Sent from general major chief of staff 13<sup>th</sup> Army - A.V. Petrushevsky (Петрушевский, Александр Васильевич) Usage is October 1942 to March 1943, with 8 numbers in the range 2 to 26.

BIIE AB (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 414, 442, 687, 1681, 1703, 1876.



Field post station (ΠΠC) 1713, dated 12.4.1942 to Kirov, Russian republic, censored at ΒΠΕ ΕΧ (39<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ΠΠC 1713 belongs to 131<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division.

Usage is only recorded in April 1942, with 2 numbers in the range 14 to 22. The cancel shape is the same as used in Vologda. BIIE BX (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 1713.



Field post station (ППС) 314, 29.12.1942 to Tatarskaya ASSR, censored at ВПБ ВД (2<sup>nd</sup> Tank Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ППС 314 belongs to 183<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Division, 3<sup>rd</sup> Reserve Army. Usage is December 1942 to February 1943, with 8 numbers in the range 2 to 23.

BITE BJJ ( $2^{\text{nd}}$  period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 314, 435, 1718.

21st Army (ВПБ Ч)

Field post station (ΠΠC) 1466, 25.3.1942 to Kazakstan republic, censored at ΒΠΕ Կ (21st Army), 1st period. ΠΠC 1466 belongs to Staff, 21st Army, this unit fought in the battle of Kharkov.

Usage is November 1941 to April 1942. Identified censor cancels from the 1st period are very rare.

BIIE 4 (1st period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 834, 976, 1466.



Registered letter field post station ( $\Pi\Pi$ C) 656, 25.5.1942 to Moscow, Russian republic, censored at B $\Pi$ B  $\Psi$  (21st Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. Registered field post letters are rare.

ΠΠC 656 belongs to 227th Infantry Division, 21st Army, this unit fought in the battle of Kharkov.

Usage is April 1942 to January 1943, with 18 numbers in the range 2 to 30.

BIIG Y (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 547, 590, 656, 976, 1455, 1466, 1687, 3695. Postage is 90 kopek (in the period 6<sup>th</sup> Feb. 1939 – 15<sup>th</sup> Sep.1948, letter until 20 gram 30 kopek + 15 kopek pr. each additional 20 gram + 30 kopek for registered fee, indication weight of letter to be 41 to 60 grams).

Field post station (ППС) 802, uncancelled, dated 16.10.1942, to Moscow, Russian republic, censored at BПБ БК ( $65^{th}$  Army),  $2^{nd}$  period.

ППС 802 belongs to 69th Infantry Division, 65th Army, Western Front.

It is three different types, usage is April 1942 to March 1943, with 14 numbers in two ranges 5 to 31, and 144 to 158. BΠΕ БЖ (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 780, 802, 1652, 1705, 1859, 1975, 2282.





Money transfer receipt through field post station (ΠΠC) 82, 27.1.1943, censored at BΠE BΠ (1nt Guard Army), 2nd period. ΠΠC 82 belongs to 207th Fighter Aviation Division, 17th Air Army, South-Western Front. *There is a message on the backside.* Usage is December 1942 to April 1943, with 11 numbers in the range 8 to 31. Money receipts are very rare with censorship. Field post station (ΠΠC) 467, 11.1.1943 to field post station 29, censored at BΠE BX (60th Army), 2nd period. ΠΠC 467 belongs to 121st Infantry Division, 60th Army, Voronezh Front, ΠΠC 29 is 9th Army Staff. Usage is July 1942 to January 1943, with 14 numbers in the range 3 to 28. Front to front letters are rare. BΠΕ BX (2nd period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 467, 1677, 1700, 1963, 1973, 2486.



Field post station (ППС) 1966, 16.10.1942, to Moscow, Russian republic, censored at BПБ BE (62<sup>nd</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ППС 1966 belongs to 203<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Division, 63<sup>rd</sup> Army, Don Front. 26<sup>th</sup> August 1942 it was defeated and had to retreat. It is four different types, usage is July 1942 to March 1943, with 13 numbers in the range 1 to 28, and the single number 113. This cancel type is only used in the beginning of the battle for Stalingrad and has been changed later on as shown on letter below. Same censor id on both cancels, but different types.

Field post station (ΠΠC) 2150, 15.12.1942 to Gorky oblast, Russian republic, censored at BΠБ BE (62<sup>nd</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. This letter was sent from Stalingrad during the battle, and shows how the mail was sent even when the hardest fighting was ongoing. ΠΠC 2150 belongs to 37<sup>th</sup> Guard Infantry Division, Stalingrad Front.

It is four different types, usage is July 1942 to March 1943, with 13 numbers in the range 1 to 28, and the single number 113. BΠΕ BE (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 808, 1455, 1593, 1769, 1794, 2024, 2150



Field post station (ΠΠC) 1576, 14.8.1942, to Leninagorsk, Kazakstan republic, censored at BΠE BA (64<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ΠΠC 1576 belongs to Staff 24<sup>th</sup> Army, Stalingrad Front.

It is two different types, usage is August 1942 to April 1943, with 15 numbers in two ranges 4 to 29.

ВПБ ВА (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 459, 492, 1576, 1704, 1705, 2146, 2222, 2302, 2339.



Field post station ( $\Pi\Pi$ C) 1704, 15.11.1942, to Severo-Kazakhstan, Kazakhstan republic, censored at B $\Pi$ B BA ( $64^{th}$  Army),  $2^{nd}$  period.

ППС 1704 belongs to 72<sup>nd</sup> Guard Infantry Division, 64<sup>th</sup> Army, Stalingrad Front.

It is two different types, usage is August 1942 to April 1943, with 15 numbers in two ranges 4 to 29.

ВПБ ВА (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 459, 492, 1576, 1704, 1705, 2146, 2222, 2302, 2339.



Field post station (ΠΠC) 1532, 26.3.1943 to Kazan, Russian republic, censored at BΠБ БР (57<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ΠΠC 1532 belongs to 60<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Division, 68<sup>th</sup> Reserve Army (built on 57<sup>th</sup> Army). It is four different types, usage is July 1942 to April 1943, with 14 numbers in the range 1 to 22. ΒΠБ БР (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 847, 1532, 1705.



Field post station (ППС) 1470, 20.1.1943 to Gorkovskoy railroad, Russian republic, censored at BПБ AC (51<sup>st</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period.

ΠΠC 1470 belongs to staff 51st Army, Southern Front.

Usage is March 1942 to March 1943, with 10 numbers in the range 2 to 24.

BIIE AC (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 181, 884, 886, 1470, 1663, 1705.

Field post station (ΠΠC) 780 29.1.1943, to Kazan, Kazan republic, censored at BΠE AIII (28<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ΠΠC 780 belongs to 6<sup>th</sup> Guards Tank Brigade, 28<sup>th</sup> Army, Southern Front. It is two different types, usage is April 1942 to March 1943, with 16 numbers in the range 1 to 27. BΠΕ AIII (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 780, 1803, 2209.



Field post station ( $\Pi\Pi$ C) 505, 1.4.1942 to Kustanai, Kazakhstan republic, censored at B $\Pi$ B X ( $12^{th}$  Army),  $2^{nd}$  period.  $\Pi\Pi$ C 505 belongs to  $12^{th}$  Army, Southern Front.

Usage is February to December 1942, with 10 numbers in the range 10 to 30. BII X (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 356, 430, 505, 538, 984.

Field post station (ΠΠC) 81, 9.9.1941 to Dnepropetrovsk oblast, Ukrainian republic, censored at BΠE T (9<sup>th</sup> Army), 1<sup>st</sup> period. ΠΠC 81 belongs to 30<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, 9<sup>th</sup> Army, Southern Front.

Usage is September 1941 to January 1942. It is a very rare censorship, and this postcard identifies the senders place as BПБ T. BПБ T (1st period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 29, 81, 803



Field post station (ΠΠC) 271, 22.6.1942 to Altaisky krai, Russian republic, censored at BΠE T (9<sup>th</sup> Army), 2<sup>nd</sup> period. ΠΠC 271 belongs to 34<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Division, 6<sup>th</sup> Army, Southwestern Front. Usage is June 1942 to February 1943, with 13 numbers in the range 2 to 23. BΠE T (2<sup>nd</sup> period) is registered sent from these field post stations: 29, 271, 883, 1495, 1867

## 4. 0 End of the Censorship



Registered Tallinn, Estonian republic, 23.6.1945 to France. The official censorship ended most likely 31.12.1945 or 1.1.1946. But the clandestine censorship on civil mail continued until the fall of the USSR, the Tallinn N cancel was used by the secret censorship. Usage is June 1946 to March 1950, and the cancel is in two different types.

The mail to/from soldiers stationed outside of the USSR was still censored.

Postage is 110 kopek (postcard international 30 kop. + registered fee international 80 kop. (1st May 1936 - 9th June 1950)).



Dnepropetrovsk, Ukrainian republic, unclear date 1946 to West Germany, with clandestine censorship Kiev. The Kiev cancel was used in the period May 1946 to March 1950.

US censor in Offenbach (Main) in the American Zone, West Germany. This censor office was in activity from 1st July 1945 to 18th August 1947 (the office was closed down on this date with a 5 minutes warning during working hours). Postcard abroad 30 kopek in the period 1st May 1936 – 9th June 1950 (10 kopek missing).
